

STUDENTS WELFARE SCHEME 2022-23

The Students Welfare Committee invites application from students belonging to the economically weaker strata of the society for extending financial assistance to them.

Students who belong to the **economically weaker sections** of the society are required to fill up the **Students Welfare Form** available in the college office with Mr. Prasad Mane OR can download it from the college website.

Requisite documents must be attached along with the form and submitted to Mr. Prasad Mane on or before 08-10-2022

(Forms will NOT be accepted after the due date)

The forms received from the students will be scrutinised and students would be called for interview with the SWC.

The final list of the beneficiary students will be displayed by the SWC after verification of documents and interview of the applicant.

Important

This Scheme is for the students of S K Somaiya College of Art, Science and Commerce.

Those students who have **ALREADY received financial** support from any other source are not eligible under this scheme.

This may be from any TRUST, Religious/Social Organisation or any NGO, etc.

Those students who are covered under SCHOLARSHIP from either the State Government or Central Government are **NOT ELIGIBLE** under this scheme.

Documents to be attached:

- Marksheet of Previous years (photocopy)
- (In case of FY student's 12th standard Marksheet)
(In case of SY and TY students all the previous semesters marksheets)
- Identity Card of the student (Photocopy)

- Income Certificate from Tehsildars Office (current year)
- Fee Receipt for the current year
- Ration card- (photocopy containing the name of the student)
- Electricity Bill of last month (July -Aug 2022) (Photocopy)

***Form should be filled in detail and no column should be kept BLANK.**

***Incomplete Forms or forms without documents and incomplete documents will be rejected.**

***Submit all the documents together.**

Kindly note that this is an independent and voluntary initiative by the S K Somaiya College of Arts, Science and Commerce and is not connected with any government (State or Central) program or scheme which provides financial assistance to the students.

The Funds for this scheme are generated through Voluntary Contributions from the Teachers, non-Teaching Staff, alumni of the college and other individual donors who wish to support our initiative.

Applying for SWS does not guarantee financial assistance.
